‘Camp Millionaire’ Coming to the Dolly Haltzman Dance Academy

“Children today are faced with a lot of dire economic news. There are three key points Schachter suggests every parent follow:

1. Set the best example you can by your own wise use of money. Children learn about money by how they see parents handle it.
2. Talk with your children about money. Invite them in on the family financial conversations.
3. Provide your children with practice experiences using money. Run the money you spend ON your kids THROUGH them.

Camp Millionaire is open to all of Haltzman Tracy’s students but will be part of the education RDT provides to students who are part of RDT's Talent Identification Program (TIP) which provides a free dance education to urban at-risk and disadvantaged elementary, middle and high school students.
