### The Dates

There is a restaurant and bar in the main building. They provide a continental breakfast from 6-10 every morning in a small room in the main building. Not the nicest accommodations, but sufficient if all you need is a bed and a bathroom. Located within walking distance of the Chabad Labuvitch building where the training will be. They also have a van that can transport you to and from the Lehigh Valley International Airport.
